Berean- I have come that they may have life, and have it in all its fullness.

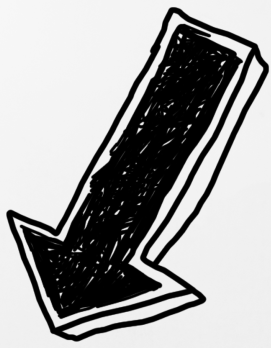
Aramaic- I have come that they may have life and have whatever is abundant.

GWT- I came so that my sheep will have life and so that they will have everything they need.

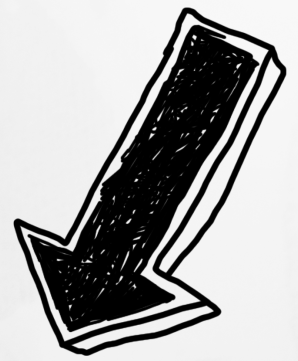
Amp- I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows

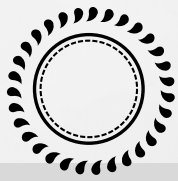

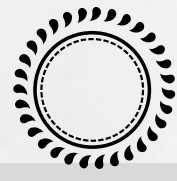
